Our community in cooperation with Livingston First Christian Church at 320 Oakley St. and Livingston First Methodist at 104 Roberts St. in Livingston, TN, will be hosting the Chrysalis weekend. The young men's conference room, prayer chapel, and sleeping area will be at First Christian Church while the young women will use the facilities at First Methodist. As always, meals will be served together at First Methodist. The clergy talks and the marriage talk will be given together in the sanctuary of First Methodist. Each group will have separate chapel times, agape, and snacks.

Using two separate locations is a new experience for our community, and it allows extra opportunities for service. Come over to help with set up and take down, serve meals, or spend time praying for the butterflies. Remember that the butterflies always enjoy homemade snacks and be preparing your agape gifts early. Please note the dates and times listed for sendoff, community service, and closing service. They are Thursday, Friday, and Saturday which is different than Emmaus.
